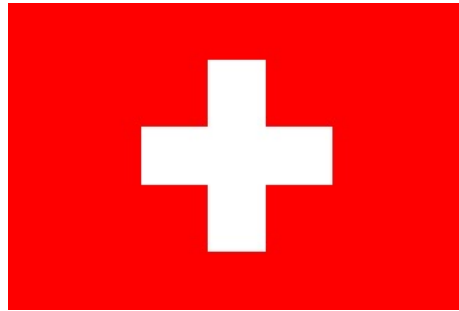

Discover Zurich's fascinating Old Town and travel back through more than 2,000 years of history. Explore the winding alleys and hear legends of the city's foundation. Walk by the remains of the Roman baths, churches with monumental towers, and medieval guild houses on this 6 hours private tour into the past. This tour through the Old Town is a rewarding journey of discovery for both visitors and locals. Come face to face with Zurich's past and present through a selection of amazing buildings, stories, and anecdotes. You will be fascinated by the rich testimonies to bygone days which document the early international significance of the city. You will visit the Old Town with its churches, walk and drive along the beautiful River Limmat, then ride on the aerial cable car for a breathtaking view over Lake Zürich and the snow-covered Alps! You will walk along The Lindenhof hill, the site of the Roman castle at the location of the Celtic Oppidum Zürich-Lindenhof, rebuilt in Carolingian times but derelict by the 13th century, when it was used as a source for building stone for the first stone houses of rich burghers of the recently reichsfrei city. The Schipfe quarter at the Limmat below the Lindenhof is the site of the Roman vicus, with traces of a hypocaustum nearby the Münsterhof excavated. St. Peter church was the parish church of the medieval city, built on the site of an earlier temple to Jupiter. Tour will last 4 hours and will be conducted by your driver guide.

Day trip to Interlaken. At 10.15 your driver will pick you up at Baur au Lac to take you to Zurich Central Station. Your train to Interlaken Ost IC814 will be departing Zurich at 10.40. It arrives in Bern at 11.58. In Bern change to train IC967 departing Bern at 12.04 with arrival in Interlaken Ost at 12.57. Your Interlaken guide will be meeting you right at the train station to escort you for a 2 hours walking tour of Interlaken. Interlaken lies in the Bernese Oberland on an alluvial plain, between Lake Thun and Lake Brienz. The vacation destination, which is presided over by the three mighty mountains, Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau, is the starting point for numerous activities. By the beginning of the 19th century Interlaken in the Bernese Oberland had already become renowned for its impressive mountain scenery. Famous contemporaries such as Johann Wolfgang von Goethe and Felix Mendelssohn traveled in these mountains. Interlaken's success as a tourist destination was further enhanced by the completion of the Bernese Oberland Railway in 1890 and the Jungfrau Railway in 1912. Your guide will show you some incredible hidden spot of Interlaken. Your return train IC978 will be departing from Interlaken Ost at 16.00. It arrives in Bern at 16.52. In Bern change train and take IC827 departing at 17.02 to Zurich with arrival at 18.16. No direct-no stop train available. Your driver will be waiting for you at Zurich train station for your transfer to Baur au Lac.

Saltzburg walking tour. Your guide will meet you in the lobby of your hotel at 10.00. You will start your discovery of Saltbug with a walking tour. Salzburg is on the border of Germany, with views of the Eastern Alps. The city is divided by the Salzach River, with medieval and baroque buildings of the pedestrian Altstadt (Old City) on its left bank, facing the 19th-century Neustadt (New City) on its right. The Altstadt birthplace of famed composer Mozart is preserved as a museum displaying his childhood instruments.

Don't miss Canovas memorial to Marie Christine! Outstanding! Next highlight will be the "Hofburgkapelle", where the Vienna boys choir perform Sunday morning since 1498. Also the imperial treasury, which houses the crown jewels and many more attractions, are on my list. Our way continues through the Swiss Gate onto the Reichskanzleitrakt, where Francis Joseph and his wife Sisi lived. Once on the hero square, you will figure out personally, why so many people point out, "this is the most beautiful city world wide". But we still are on our way to the spanish riding school and I will introduce you the story of the world famous Lipizzan horses. Afterwards we will walk along the Kohlmarkt, Vienna's most elegant shopping street and we will see if we can stay outside the Demel confectionery, which is famous for their delicious pastries. After seeing St Peters church and the plague column we will reach our final destination, the majestic Saint Stephen's Cathedral. A tour to discover Vienna's major sights in the city-centre. You will love it!

Morning visit of Hofburg Palace. Because of the wonderful location of your hotel you will reach Hofburg Palace walking. 9 minutes from the Bristol. In Sisi's footsteps, the Imperial home and household. For many centuries, the Vienna Hofburg was the centre of the Habsburg empire. Three museum attractions provide historically accurate insights into the tradition and daily life at court: the authentically-furnished Imperial Apartments, the tasteful Sisi Museum and the Silver Collection as a comprehensive collection of Imperial utilitarian objects. The Imperial Apartments, Sisi Museum and the Silver Collection are amongst Vienna's top sights, attracting around 600,000 visitors each year.

Soon after lunch you will depart for a quick visit of Bratislava. Driving time to Bratislava will be approx. 1 hour for a distance of 50 miles. Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia, is set along the Danube River by the border with Austria and Hungary. It's surrounded by vineyards and the Little Carpathian mountains, crisscrossed with forested hiking and cycling trails. The pedestrian-only, 18th-century old town is known for its lively bars and cafes. Perched atop a hill, the reconstructed Bratislava Castle overlooks old town and the Danube.
