




Upon arrival at Ben Gurion airport in Tel Aviv of flight UA90V at 16.20 you will be met at the door of your

Private Arrival transfer from TLV airport to Hotel American Colony




In Jerusalem you will stay at American Colony Hotel. The rich history of the American Colony Jerusalem dates back to the late nineteenth century, following a series of tragic events that led Horatio and Anna Spafford, a devoutly Christian family, to leave their home town of Chicago in 1881 in order to find peace in the holy city of Jerusalem and to offer aid to families in distress. Seventy Swedes living in the United States joined 'the Americans' in 1894, followed by another fifty five from Nas in Sweden two years later, and the now much larger group required bigger premises. The home they bought was initially built as a palace for a pasha and his four wives. That palace would soon become The American Colony Hotel. The American Colony Hotel has a unique place in the history of the area, having endured countless challenges and a series of wars. The original founders retained their former home in the Old City and used it for charitable purposes, providing care to needy children with services that grew over the decades. Today this building houses the Spafford Children's Center, which runs medical, infant welfare and social work departments for local children. Although the daily management of the hotel was handed over by the Spafford's grandson, Horatio Vester, upon his retirement in 1980, to Gauer Hotels of Switzerland, the American Colony is still owned and run by the descendants of the original founding community. Its board of directors is composed of family members who remain closely involved. The Colony is a part of their family history, just as it is a part of the history of Jerusalem. 


Wednesday, 27 December 2017

You will reach the Upper Rooms on Mt. Zion where the Last Supper was held. Your guide will suggest a local restaurant for lunch. After lunch you go back where it all began at the City of David where you will see the Pool of Siloam and wade through Hezekiah's tunnels. You will have option for wet or dry tunnels. Your guide will take you inside the Church of Visitation where you could renew your vows in Ein Kerem. The Virgin Mary's visit to Elizabeth was first set in a place other than that of the birth of Saint John at the beginning of the 14th century: "Zechariah's house is in the mountains of Judea.. In this place there are two churches... and between these churches flows a spring that is quite full of water. At the site of the

first church, it is said, Elisabeth was greeted by the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is also said that the blessed John the Baptist was hidden there during the Slaughter of the Innocents. At the site of the second church, the blessed John the Baptist was born. Back to the American Colony in late afternoon.




Jerusalem




Masada
